However, written notice must be given to the Trial Secretary, no later than 6:00 PM on Monday, November 5 or at the close of the trial on Friday and Saturday which will be considered the awarding of ribbons for the last class of that day. Move-ups will be added to the end of the running order of the class they move up to. Every effort will be made to accommodate handlers running multiple dogs in the same class. No verbal changes can be accepted.

All express mail must be left with no acceptance signature required. Entry form changes, additions, corrections and cancellations **MUST** be received in **writing** prior to the final closing date, be legible and include the AKC number, or no refund will be issued. No telephone changes accepted. E-mail changes are welcomed.

FOOD: Food is not available on the show site for exhibitors at these trials. There are restaurants within walking distance or nearby and a deli in Knowlan's Grocery.

CRATING SPACE: Limited with no ex-pens being allowed. Crate in designated areas only. No crating is allowed in the back hallway behind the men's restroom.

WARM-UPS: A warm-up area in lunchroom-crating area, consisting of a regulation agility jump, will be provided for all exhibitors.

OBSTACLES: Obstacles will meet the specifications for obstacles in the current edition of the Regulations for Agility Trials.

DOGS ELIGIBLE TO ENTER: As it states in the Regulations for Agility Trials, Chapter 1, Section 3, All dogs fifteen (15) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners listing number, or approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds are eligible to participate except bitches in heat, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance. Dogs or registerable breeds with accepted foreign registration numbers are eligible to participate.

HEIGHT DIVISIONS: Owners are responsible for entering the proper height division. All measurements are at the dog's withers.

Regular classes

Dogs MAY enter a higher jump height.
8 inches: 11" and under at the withers
12 inches: 14" and under at the withers
16 inches: 18" and under at the withers
20 inches: 22" and under at the withers
24 inches: For dogs over 22" at the withers
24 inch Choice: May be entered at owner's discretion

Preferred Classes

Dogs MAY NOT enter a higher jump height
4 inches: 11" and under at the withers
8 inches: 14" and under at the withers
12 inches: 18" and under at the withers
16 inches: 22" and under at the withers
20 inches: More than 22" at the withers

REFUNDS: Entry fees for females that come into season and injured dogs after the closing date will be refunded (minus a \$10.00 administrative fee per day) if a veterinarian certificate is presented to the trial secretary prior to the start of judging. Refunds will not be given for refund amounts of \$ 5 or less. No entry fees will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee. Entry fees shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by vet or judge, or barred from competition by action of the trial committee.

PRIZE AND AWARDS: Flat ribbons will be awarded for the 1st through 4th place dogs in each STD, JWW and Premier class and 1st place in T2B. A green qualifying ribbon will be awarded to all dogs earning a qualifying score. "New Title" ribbons will be available for qualifying teams. A MACH/PACH bar and Rosette will be awarded to each team earning a MACH/PACH. The club reserves the right to substitute prizes of equal or greater value. All awards and prizes must be claimed at the show as none will be mailed.

1st Prize: Blue 2nd Place: Red 3rd Place: Yellow 4th Place: White
Qualifying Ribbon: Dark Green

RINGSIDE: Dogs may arrive any time prior to judging if the dog has a valid temporary or permanent jump height card. Otherwise, they must be available for measuring prior to the start of their class if a VMO or AKC Field Rep is available to measure dogs. All dogs not needed for further judging will be excused.

Judges are not required to wait for dogs. The Owner of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at ringside when it is to be judged. The Club has no responsibility for providing service through a public address system or stewards or runners for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought into the ring when required.

SAFETY/BEHAVIOR and LIABILITY: The safety of the dog is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely. It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create an unnecessary disturbance or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the trial committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made. The St Paul Dog Training Club and its agents, employees, etc., will assume no responsibilities for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors or handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children. The St Paul Dog Training Club reserves the right to decline entries for cause and may remove any dog on account of aggression. No one shall have any recourse or claim against the St Paul Dog Training Club or any official thereof. **All dogs must be on leash** at all times when on trial grounds except when in the designated warm-up area or competing on the course.

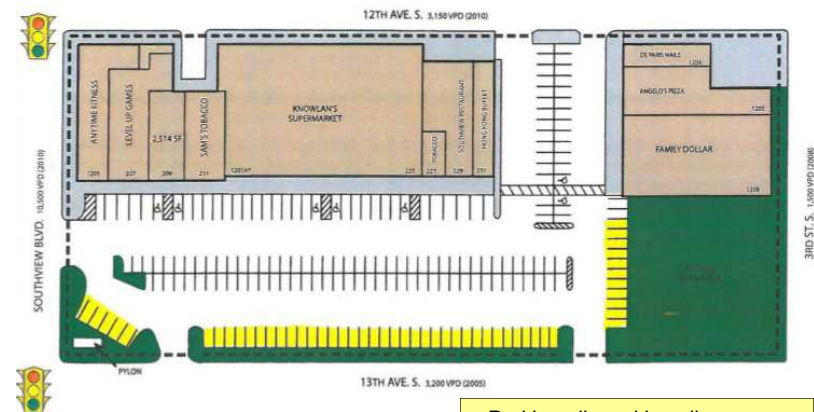

I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem sufficient. I (we) certify and represent that the dog entered is not a hazard to persons or other dogs. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog. INSTRUCTIONS

Handlers whose dogs measure into the 8" through 20" regular jump height divisions may opt to enter in a higher or 24-choice height division for all Regular titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs who measure into the 24" regular jump height division may not enter 24-choice. Dogs entered in the Preferred classes must compete at the required jump height and **may not** compete in a jump height division **higher or lower** than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an Agility Jump Height Card may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial or *back-to-back trials* only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.

Dogs listed in the AKC Canine Partners ProgramSM may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC agility trials at the club's option. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box.

Junior Handlers should enter their Junior Handler Number on the front of this form. Should you not have your Junior Handler number, it may be obtained from the American Kennel Club (919) 233-9767. If the Junior Handler is not the owner of the dog identified on the face of this form, what is the relationship of the Junior Handler to the Owner?
